1 Housing

On-Campus Housing:

- Only available for graduate and professional students or undergraduates w/ spouse and/or dependent children.
- All utilities included (electric, water, internet), unfurnished.
- Inexpensive, but waitlist is often 2+ years.

Things to consider:

- Distance from campus and shopping.
- Bus routes and/or bike lanes.
- Utilities included/not included (setting up GRU may require deposit). International students must set up utilities in person.
- Deposit/1st/Last month's rent often required (may be up to 3x monthly rent due on lease signing).
- Application fee and/or background check needed?
- Private vs. Shared bathroom.
- Furnished vs. Unfurnished.
- Proof of income is often required, especially for apartment complexes or corporate landlords. Smaller landlords may be more flexible.



- Will you need to find your own roommates or does the apartment match you with roommates?
- Apartments in Midtown are generally the most expensive though also the closest to main campus. Most complexes here are geared towards undergraduates. Apartments on/around Archer Road are generally less expensive, the area has lots of shopping but isn't as walkable.
- Proof of income is generally 3x the monthly rent. Some apartments complexes/landlords might require a guarantor to co-sign the lease who meets that criterion. Make sure to ask about their guarantor policy if you are looking to rent by yourself.

2 Transportation

- Free bus for anyone with a Gator1 Card.
- Bus service is less frequent nights/weekends/holidays.

- Gator Gears Bicycle Rental Service, available in semester or annual increments.
- Secure Bicycle Parking Facility in Parking Garage 14.
- Bike Repair Shop in Reitz Union https://sg.ufl.edu/services/bike-repair
- 28 DIY Bike Repair stations are located across campus, though they aren't always working.
- Gainesville has several good bike shops.

- Free nighttime shuttle van.
- On-demand service, stops are mostly on campus and midtown and some larger off-campus apartment complexes.

- Student parking pass costs \$160/year.
- Parking on the main campus may be limited during peak hours.
- Pay close attention to color codes/signs to avoid parking tickets!
